- PPI links engineering students with businesses
- Projects focus on reductions in energy, emissions, and/or waste
- Interns work with company for 10 weeks during summer
- Company provides \$12/hr of intern's salary (approximately \$5,280)

Operating/ Disposal Savings	\$0.38-0.46 million	\$1.2 million	\$2.3 million	\$0.7 million	\$5.7 million

- Implementation rate – 66% (soon to be 75%)
- Combined company investment – \$102,000
